



## Terms and Conditions

1. This competition is open to residents of the UK, Channel Islands, Isle of Man and Republic of Ireland aged 18 years or over.

Sound files should be no more that 3MB. Entrants should include their own name, address, telephone number and email address. We regret that we are unable to accept postal entries.
4. All entries must be received by the advertised closing time and date.
5. All images and files submitted must demonstrate work of the individual submitting them and must not have been published elsewhere or have won a prize in any other competition. It is the responsibility of each entrant to ensure that any images they submit have been taken with the permission of the subject and do not infringe the copyright of any third party or any laws.
